

Genesis 2

- 2:1** The heavens and the earth and all the hosts of them were finished.
- 2:2** And on the seventh day Elohim (God) finished his work which He did; and on the seventh day, He rested from all of the work He did.
- 2:3** And Elohim (God) blessed the seventh day and made it holy (for) He himself rested from all of His work which Elohim (God) created and did.
- 2:4** These are the genealogies of the heavens and the earth when they were created in the day Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) made the earth and heavens.
- 2:5** And before any of the shrub of the field was in the earth and before any of the herb of the field sprouted, Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) had not caused rain on the earth and there was no human to till the ground.
- 2:6** And humidity ascended from the earth and irrigated all of the surface of the ground.
- 2:7** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) the human from the soil of the ground and blew in his nostrils the breath of life and the human became a living soul.
- 2:8** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) planted a garden eastward in Eden, and He placed there the human whom He formed.
- 2:9** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) caused to sprout from the ground every tree coveted by sight and good for food; the tree of life in the midst of the garden and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.
- 2:10** And a stream going forth from Eden to irrigate the garden from there parted and became four heads.
- 2:11** The name of the first is Pison: the one surround all the land of Havilah where there is gold.
- 2:12** And the gold in the land is good. There is pearl and the onyx stone
- 2:13** And the name of the second stream is Gihon and surrounds all the land of Cush (Ethiopia).
- 2:14** And the name of the third stream is Hiddekel the one going east toward

Asshur (Assyria). And the fourth stream is Euphrates.

- 2:15** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) took the human and left him in the garden of Eden to serve it and keep it.
- 2:16** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) instructed the human saying, "from any of the trees of the garden you shall eat.
- 2:17** But from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it. That in the day you eat from it, you shall die."
- 2:18** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) said, "It is not good for the human to be alone; I shall make for him a helper to be in front of him."
- 2:19** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) formed from the ground every animal of the field and every bird of the heavens and brought them to the human to see what he shall call them. And all which the human called them, that was their name.
- 2:20** And the human named all the beasts and the birds of the heavens and all the animals of the field. And for Adam, he did not find a helper to be in front of him.
- 2:21** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) caused to fall a stupor upon the human, and he slept; and He took one rib from him and closed the flesh.
- 2:22** And Jehovah (Jesus) Elohim (God) built from the rib which He took from the human a woman whom He brought to the human.
- 2:23** And the human said, "One bone from my bones and flesh from my flesh, she shall be called, Woman; that this one, was taken from man.
- 2:24** So a man leaves his father and his mother and he clings to his woman and they become one flesh.
- 2:25** And the two of them were naked, the human and his woman and they did not shame themselves.
